- November 15, 1941 501st Parachute Infantry Regiment formed.
- November 15th, 1948. 82nd Airborne based at Ft. Bragg NC.
- November 28, 1980. Maroon Beret reinstated.
- November 29th, 1944. Operation Tabletop, Philippines.

Airborne History on Veteran's Day, 2020

Veterans Day is observed on November 11 and it honors all honorably discharged U.S. military veterans. It originally marked the anniversary of the end of World War I when hostilities ended at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918. Previously called Armistice Day, the holiday was renamed Veterans Day in 1954.

The 82nd Airborne division has stood guard and protected America since 1917 and has done so with courage, honor, and sacrifice to include World War 1, World War 2, Vietnam, The Cold War, Dominican Republic, Grenada, Panama, Desert Shield and Desert Storm, Kosovo, Operation Enduring Freedom, and Operation Iraqi Freedom.
